Description (max. 100 words)	<p>This course commences with: the basic principles of law governing and involving commercial contracts; sources of commercial law; conclusion and termination of contract; pre-contractual duties and responsibilities. The course then considers particular types of commercial contracts such as: sale contract, publishing contract, construction contract, storage contract, contract on control goods and services, management contract, consulting contract, commercial agency contract, contract of assignment and cession contract. The basic aspects of antimonopoly law and consumer protection law is also considered, as well as contracts for founding companies. The last part of course deals with issues concerning securing the performance of commercial contracts.</p>

Finally, the course provides an detailed outline of the Serbian constitutional system and basic principles and provisions of the Serbian Constitution.

Special emphasis is on judicial cases and questions raised in practice regarding some offenses (especially actual ones, in focus of public attention, e.g. family/intimate partner violence, trafficking in people, exploitation and abuse of children, etc).</p>				
Learning outcomes (max. 50 words)	<p>Students shall acquire theoretical knowledge of the characteristics of a group of crimes referred to in the Criminal Code and of individual offenses. Students shall be qualified to independently apply criminal law provisions (in terms of determining the legal qualification of the offense, the proper demarcation of crimes with similar characteristics, the basic distinction, aggravated or simple forms of individual crime, ways of establishing the factual and subjective characteristics of offenses, and the like).</p>
